Symbiosis of the Life-Force

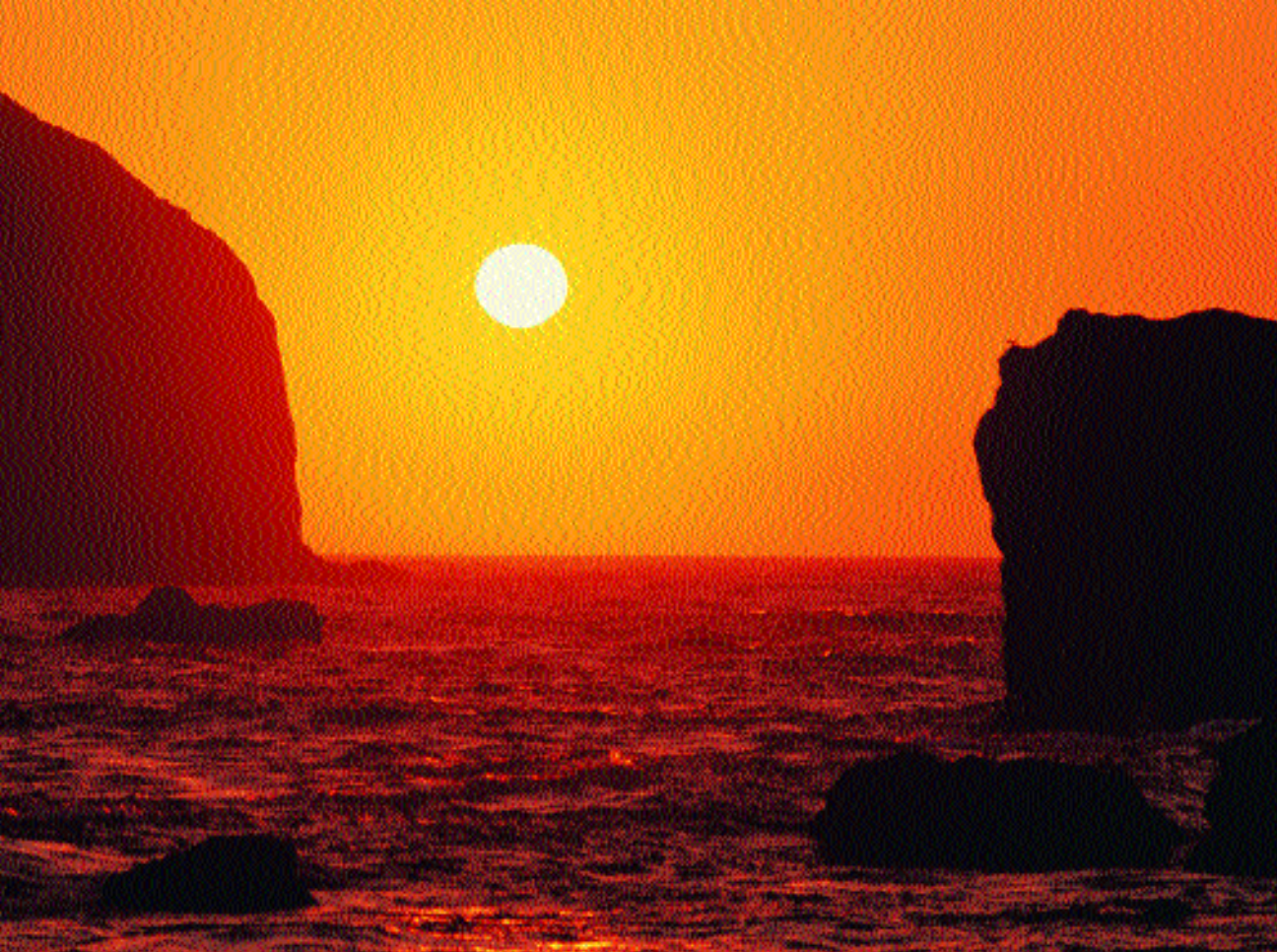


At this point our understanding of the two elements of water and salt should have expanded within our consciousness, taking us to a higher level, allowing us to look at this topic from a completely new perspective. All life-giving processes in our universe, from the macrocosm to the microcosm, are closely interlinked to the energy potentials that are released when water merges with salt. These diamagnetic energies that are released by the combination of salt and water, act implosively (temperature decreasing) according to nature's blueprint. The blend of water and salt, the so-called sole, is the "mother soup" of all life forms and a flexible, physical representation of pure sun and light energy. The word sole is derived from the Latin word for sun "sol", as it is the liquid materialization of sunlight. Sole means "liquid sunlight" or "liquid light energy."

Sole - an Ocean of Energy

When water and salt connect, the negative poles of the water molecules surround the positive ions in the salt and the negative ions in the salt are surrounded by the positive polarized particles of the water molecules. This changes the geometric structure of the water and the salt, and creates something entirely new, a third dimension. The water is no longer water and the salt no longer salt. On the Intelligence of Atoms and Humans

The further we break down matter into its components, the more potent its frequency spectrum becomes—physically speaking. As the nucleus measures a higher frequency spectrum than the atom itself, the element within a molecule again measures a higher frequency spectrum than the molecule itself, the molecule higher than the cell, and the cell yet higher than the organ, and so forth. In this case, energy, as information, is equal to intelligence, which means that the individual atom is far more intelligent than the matter it creates and the individual cell more intelligent than the organ it builds.

The human, made of the sum of all elements, cells and organs, is less intelligent than his individual components. This could explain why our organs consist of a self-protecting system which guards them against poor nutrition. The following scale of vibrational frequencies, will support this premise:

Nucleus	10 ²² Hertz
Atom-Element	10 ¹⁵ Hertz
Molecule	10 ⁹ Hertz
Cell	10 ³ Hertz
Organ	10 ² Hertz
Human (Body)	8 to 10 Hertz

This scale shows that a single water molecule has far more intelligence than a human being. And the degree of intelligence of one individual person is again higher than that of the state or nation of which he is a citizen. This might explain why some of the federal laws are incomprehensible to us individuals.

When water and salt combine, life begins

through this process of attaining higher levels of consciousness, can we relinquish our polarities and return into the oneness of all elements. This is exactly what transpires when water and salt meet. The willingness of the water to give up its own identity, in return, liberates the salt from its manifested identity—to overcome the powers of the gridwork and to separate sodium from chloride. Both elements are ionized, which releases their stored energy and information. The same effect could be attained without water in the smelting process, extracting metal from ore, and would require a temperature of 1,500° F.



The Creation of Life

The crystalline sole contains all the elements necessary to create life

It took Earth three to four billion years to create life through the interplay of sunlight, water and salt. Most of us have forgotten that we come from the ocean. But when we look at a sperm cell, we see how it consists of 99% water and 1% salt. Looking from this perspective, a sperm cell is just like a drop of the “mother ocean”. The American chemist Stanley Miller proved that all creation began in the ocean. He showed how electric charges, placed in a sole, started to collect amino acids and combine organic matter. Although fascinating, it’s not completely accurate to say that life was created out of practically nothing. In fact, life is created out of everything, or better still, the “all” that is, because the natural crystalline sole contains all elements that exist on Earth. Our body consists of the same elements as water and salt. Even the ratio of concentration in our blood is the same as that of the primal ocean.

Begetting a Human Life - The Marri-Age of Humanity

The creation of sole from water and salt resembles the procreation of a human life. Just as the water and the salt are willing to sacrifice their own identity in order to reach a higher form

of being, new life arises out of the merging of two polarities - the sperm and the egg. The ultimate expression of self-sacrifice is when the sperm and the egg unite, becoming one, in order to create something new, a genuine act of unconditional love, the highest potential force of our creation.

Chemists refer to this process, when different elements of the same frequency and polarity merge together, as “molecular-marri-age.” Interestingly, the German word for marriage is “Hochzeit” which literally means “high time,” the most precious time of one’s entire life, when new life is made. Although the English word “marriage” has a slightly different meaning, we can arrive at the same conclusion regarding the definition. The first part of the word, “Marri,” comes from the Latin word “mare”—the ocean—the marriage of water and salt—from which all life originated. Also, in the Bible, we use the mythological term of “Mary” the mother of “Christ,” whereas “Mare” means the ocean—the SOLE—where everything had its beginning. So “Marri-Age” basically means this “Golden Age” when “Marri”- “Mare”-“Mary”-“Merry,” come together and enjoy “Sole”—“Consciousness” — at its highest, most valuable potential—when polarities overcome their existence and new life (a child) is created. This creates a resonant effect. Not only



is the energy contained, but it also increases exponentially to a new dimension—new life comes into being. In our realm we refer to this procedure as “marriage.” If our individual polarities are willing, within this marriage, to sacrifice themselves for a higher form of consciousness, then our energies increase exponentially with implosive effects to a higher dimension of consciousness. Following the inner ethical principal, it’s not only about sustaining life, but also about creating new life.

Overcoming Polarity

We Can Learn From the Elements
